2020 FIRST ROUND DUE-DILIGENCE ASSESSMENT

IA in the weekdays from September 14 to 19 had successfully conducted its organizational capacity or due-diligence assessment. This assessment conducted on more than 50 chambers and BMOs that are residing in five of the regions (i.e. Amhara, Oromia, Tigray, Harari and sidama) and the one city administration (i.e. Addis Abeba) that had submitted their proposals for the first round INNOVATIVE_GRANT FUND_IGF 2020 CALL.

The purpose of it being to identify the capacity, gap and good culture that will benefit them in implementing their projects. In addition, it aims to confirm and verify information that was brought up during the proposal submission.

The components of the due diligence were Program Management, Leadership, Governance and Human Resources, Financial Management, Membership Development, Physical Space.

In its findings IA were able to gather valuable information's regarding the Chambers/BMOs experience in program management, financial systems and other key areas
